- 8500 people known to have lost lives so far, many more lives could be lost as rescue continues

- Hospital and Health Care (First Aid) services out of operation, unable to provide immediate medicines & dressings required to tend the wounded

- Near total destruction of houses in these villages, rendering them without shelter from cold weather
- Unknown number of Livestock – their livelihood is lost
